EASTERN WASHINGTON'S FUN & FAMOUS CHAMPIONSHIP!

PGA Professional Daniel Campbell is expected to defend his title against a full field of the best PGA Professionals and top amateurs in the Pacific Northwest.

The Rosauers Open Invitational started in 1988 when a group of Spokane area Golf Professionals realized their goal of bringing a Pacific Northwest Section Major to town.

Corey Prugh holds the record for the most wins (4). Derek Bayley set the tournament record of 189 (27-under par) at MeadowWood GC in 2016. The 11-under par 60 shot by Brady Sharp is an 18-hole tournament record set at Indian Canyon GC in 2017.

INDIAN CANYON GC

H. Chandler Egan, a member of the PPGA Hall of Fame, crafted Indian Canyon in 1935 over the well-treed hillside southwest of the Spokane River. The course hosted the 1941 and 1984 Public Links Championships. When Bill Welch was victorious in 1941, he concluded, "After I played Indian Canyon, I never wanted to go back to Texas again. I did return to Texas, but only to pack my bags and move to Spokane."

This municipal track has been annually rated among Golf Digest's "Best Public Courses", "Best Affordable Courses", "Best Golf Courses You Can Play" and "Best in State."
