

## The Home Course



The Home Course was designed by golf course architect Mike Asmundson of Scottsdale, Arizona

and opened on June 29, 2007. It is a walkable layout with panoramic views of Puget Sound, the Olympic Mountains, and Mount Rainier present throughout the golf course. The Home Course was selected by the United States Golf Association as the assisting course for the 2010 U.S. Amateur Championship. It is truly a great championship golf course at the home of golf in the Pacific Northwest.

## The Oldest PNW PGA Championship

The Northwest Open is a significant part of Northwest golf history. The early years of the championship were dominated by Seattle Golf Club's Robert Johnstone (who won 6 of the first 10 events) and "Long Jim" Barnes. Marvin "Bud" Ward captured six championships over a 22 year span, five as an amateur and his last as a professional. The 54hole tournament record of 199 was set by PGA Professional Derek Barron in 2015 at Wine Valley GC and tied in 2016 by PGA Professional Brian Thornton.

## **The Field & Sponsors**
