

EXTRA DAY'S REST IS BOON TO SOLONS' MOUND STAFF

Barrett to Go After 18th Win of Season Against Sacs Tonight

SACRAMENTO, Calif., Wednesday, July 26.—If anyone gained anything from the Seattle baseball team's enforced "stopover" in Oregon yesterday, it was the Sacramento squad, which Seattle faces in the opening game of an all-important Coast League series tonight.

The teams were to have played last night, but the Seattle Rainiers, en route to Sacramento, were delayed by a detailed train ahead of their own train.

Sacramento's none-too-large pitching staff, "fagged" from a stiff series against Los Angeles last week, in which the Sacs won five games to two for the Angels, thus gained an added day of rest.

Seattle's moundmen, on the other hand, are all raring to go, and it remains to be seen what the extra day's delay in work will mean for them.

Seattle lost half a game of its lead over the Angels by not playing, as the Angels took a 6-5 win over San Francisco. The Rainiers' first-place margin is now four games even.

Kewpie Dick Barrett will take Friday night to make up for last night's postponement.

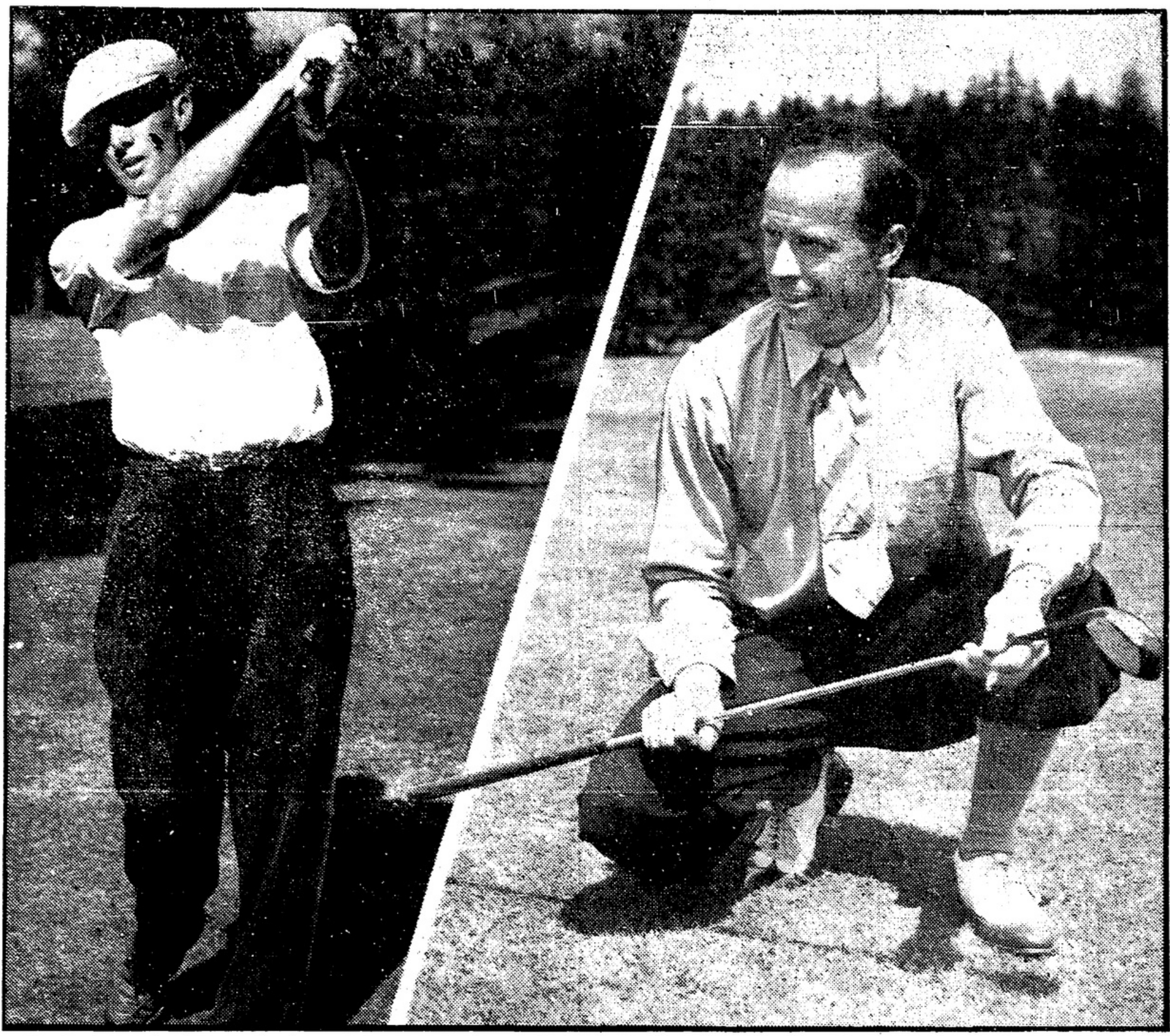
